ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TAMPERING OF WATER METERS OWNED BY THE C ITY OF PATTERSON, GEORGIA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTERSON, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME,

THAT FROM AND AFTER THE PASSAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE, IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO TAMPER WITH THE WATER METERS BELONGING TO THE CITY WHEN THEY HAVE BEEN TURNED OFF DUE TO NON-PAYMENT OF WATER AND SEWER BILLS.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY AFORESAID, THAT ANY

PERSON VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE FINED

TWENTY-FIVE (25.00) DOLLARS AND HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE VIOLATION

AS STATED IN SECTION TWENTY-EIGHT (28) OF HOUBE BILL NUMBER 651, PATTERSON CITY CHARTER.
